Major Casino

South Africa

Brief

To project manage the build of South Africa's first legal casino and manage the transition from the temporary site to the permanent site. Consult on gaming, staffing and workforce development and transition.

Delivering the Project

The first stage was to build a temporary casino, to generate revenue whilst the permanent casino was being built. The temporary casino would later be converted into a sports facility which would include a boxing academy aimed at under privileged children.

The temporary casino was to house around 20 tables and slot machine area 500 machines. Tables and slot machines were sourced and an appropriate layout designed and implemented.

A combination of experienced and un-experienced gaming staff were recruited and a training programme was developed for each level of experience. In order to comply with government regulations and employment we developed policies and procedures that would make future recruitment easier.

The temporary casino was opened within 6 months and quickly became popular so much so that it was necessary to build an extension to the temporary building.

- Development of a training programme for new and existing staff
- Smooth transition from a temporary casino to a permanent site
